Re: (PROPOSED) Comprehensive Federal Election Legislation for 2025/2026

Dear Legislator, Journalist, Citizens of the United States of America

This proposal is presented by Election Integrity Project[®] *California*, Inc. (EIPCa), an all-volunteer, California §501(c)(3) public benefit corporation which promotes, through education, research, and advocacy the civil rights of California citizens to fully participate in a lawful election process under Federal and state law.

EIPCa, being a non-partisan organization, does not participate in political campaigns, nor endorse candidates for office. EIPCa focuses on the voting process. Its purpose is well stated in its motto so **“Every lawfully cast vote is accurately counted.”** EIPCa believes that the election process is the cornerstone of self-governance and the preservation of our Constitutional Republic.

EIPCa’s activities include (1) training citizens to observe and document irregularities in the procedures used to manage elections, process ballots, and report irregularities and corruptive activities to county officials and the CA Secretary of State, and (2) regularly requesting and auditing county and California voter registration data to determine compliance with NVRA’s list maintenance obligations and providing the county election officials and/or California’s Secretary of State with Findings Reports.

EIPCa has amassed 14 years’ worth of evidence of the negative impact of “California Model” laws and regulations on the integrity and validity of California’s election process, much of which comprises the citations in the Proposal.

In 2022, EIPCa retained Advocates for Faith and Freedom (AFF), whose purpose from its founding has been to serve as a public interest law firm to safeguard the Constitutional liberties that define the United States.

After 15 years of advocating for fair, honest and transparent elections for California citizens, EIPCa has concluded that the election process has become so corrupt and easily manipulated that citizens can no longer choose their representatives.

- In 2015 EIPCa provided documentation of the 2012, 2013, 2014 elections to the California Advisory Committee to the U.S Commission on Civil Rights to address violations of HAVA which resulted in a Hearing on August 28, 2015.
The report was buried.
- In 2017 EIPCa retained Landmark Legal Foundation to review the evidence gathered by approximately 11,000 EIP/EIPCa-trained Observers and the EIPCa Data Research. Landmark Legal filed FOUR Briefs with the Dept. of Justice and the Dept. of Homeland Security. **They were ignored.**
- In 2020 EIPCa sent three letters to Mr. Elliott M. Davis, Acting Principal Deputy Assistant Attorney General U.S. Department of Justice Civil Rights Division regarding VoteCal, California’s “unreliable” statewide voter roll database.
There was no response.

Election Integrity Project® *California* and Advocates for Faith and Freedom respectfully offer the accompanying Proposal for Comprehensive Election Integrity Legislation (see thumb drive) to restore focus on the purpose of the election process, not only for California, but for the entire country, as it appears many states are now implementing the same California-style election laws that have created “corruptive entry points” into virtually every aspect of the election process.
