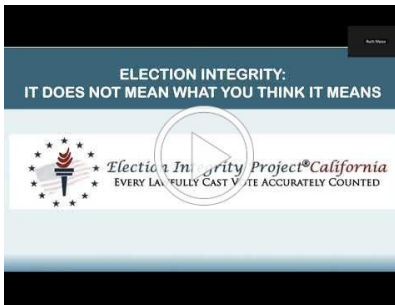




Election Integrity It Does Not Mean What You Think It Means

15 years ago, very few legislators, media outlets or journalists were willing to talk about election integrity.

Now the term “election integrity” is everywhere.

Those who have the most to lose by transparency and needed reform regularly clutch their collective pearls and protest the very notion that anyone would question their “perfect” system.

Grifters in every state often fly the phrase as a flag of legitimacy and as a battle cry to attract the financial contributions of desperate people who know their voices have been silenced and the Republic replaced by a Socialist Oligarchy.

Meanwhile, a good number of legitimate people and organizations are working with laudable dedication to restore “election integrity” as they define it.

- swift and accurate tabulation of every lawful vote (elimination of hackable electronic voting system equipment)
- complete transparency
- reasonable access for every eligible citizen to vote

But Election Integrity is so much more.

If we are to continue the difficult journey toward true election integrity, we must have a strong grasp on its much broader definition.

Election Integrity is the cornerstone of Liberty and Freedom. It forms the pillars upon which the idea, the dream, the reality of the America created by the Founders rests.

It is why America - as it was founded - WORKS, and why its corruption and disintegration threaten the very existence of that America.

A key portion of EIPCa’s stated Mission is “to fulfill our [American citizens] duty to **actively participate** in the governing of our state/country, a government of, by, and for the People.”

That full participation is the true definition of Election Integrity.

Active participation in governing, in other words “self-governance,” is not fulfilled by merely casting a vote.

Election integrity is complete, active and ceaseless self-governance.

Self-governance begets true FREEDOM, and can be attained and sustained ONLY through personal RESPONSIBILITY.

As a society we are rapidly forgetting what makes us great, unique, prosperous, blessed.

We must ELECT to live in harmony with our creator and the natural world He provides us, in harmony with our own better nature, in harmony with our fellow compatriots, and in harmony with everyone else world-wide who chooses to acknowledge each person’s and country’s right to autonomy and self-governance.

We must ELECT to do what it takes to dismantle the current corrupt systems within our own governmental agencies.

We must ELECT to be Americans in the mold of the first colonists and Founders of the greatest country in the history of human civilization, united by a mutual pledge of our lives, fortunes and sacred honor.

We must ELECT honorable public servants. The absolute integrity of the election system is vital to protect the People's right to elect their representatives, and fire those who betray their trust.
