



IT'S NOT OVER UNTIL IT'S OVER

Voting in the 2022 Primary Election is over, but the election results are NOT.

The winners that have been “called” are not definite.

- Results we are seeing now are simply the media’s BEST GUESS, a prediction. And they are not always right in the end.
- **There are still 2-3 weeks of ballot processing** (sorting, scanning, signature verification, extraction, inspection, duplicating, curing, adjudication and tabulation) before results are final.

Every ballot processing stage is vulnerable to error and intentional manipulation.

For the sake of election integrity, observers are still very much needed.

EIPC_a calls on all concerned citizens who can **maintain a non-partisan and respectful demeanor** to show up as often and for as long as they can to observe the processing of ballots in their county **for the next 2-3 weeks**.

Politely ask questions of the Supervisor if you perceive something of concern

Voter Bill of Rights:

- (9) (A) You have the right to ask questions about election procedures and observe the election process.
- (B) You have the right to ask questions of the precinct board and elections officials regarding election procedures and to receive an answer or be directed to the appropriate official for an answer.

However, if persistent questioning disrupts the execution of their duties, the precinct board or elections officials may discontinue responding to questions.
