AB 1411

OPPOSE UNLESS AMENDED

Members of the Committee,

Election Integrity Project® *California*, Inc. (EIPCa) **opposes AB 1411** unless amended as recommended below.

1. The intent of the Legislature should NOT be “to maintain voter registration at the highest possible level” but “to educate and motivate as many eligible California citizens as possible to register, vote and engage in the process of citizen self-governance.”

High numbers on the voter rolls are dangerous and certainly not boast-worthy if they are bolstered by ineligible registrants (non-citizens, deceased, duplicates and those no longer living in California).

2. All eligible Californians should be the focus of such an education and motivation campaign, not just potential voters in selected counties.

AB 1411 as currently written is careless in its language and inexplicably narrow in its focus.

EIPCa supports **AB 1411 only if** those flaws are remedied as suggested above.
